

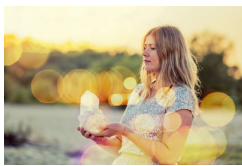

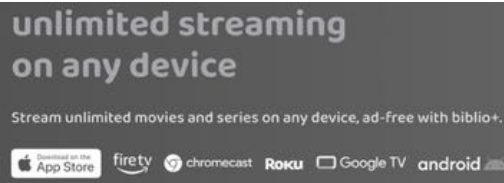
We have added new digital resources to our collection line up. Visit our Digital Resources page on our website to view all of our digital resources.
